# Virus



Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus carry the virus




#### Diagnostic: Blood test detect viral RNA or antibodies


#### Prevention

### Disease

- Incubation (3-7 days)
- Symptoms resolve within 10 days



## Treatment

- ONLY supportive measures, no treatment
- Hydration
- Paracetamol (fever control)
- Narcotics, ibuprofen, aspirin (muscle and joint pain)



## Dengue


- Chikungunya and dengue viruses are transmitted by the same mosquitoes
- Symptoms can be difficult to distinguish

\* Do not offer NSAIDs (aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen) If Dengue is suspected. Increases risk of hemorrhage


#### Symptoms of Dengue Fever

#### Symptoms of Chikungunya



Critical phase - hypotension - pleural effusion - ascites - gastrointestinal bleeding

> Recovery phase - altered level of consciousness - seizures - itching - slow heart rate
